

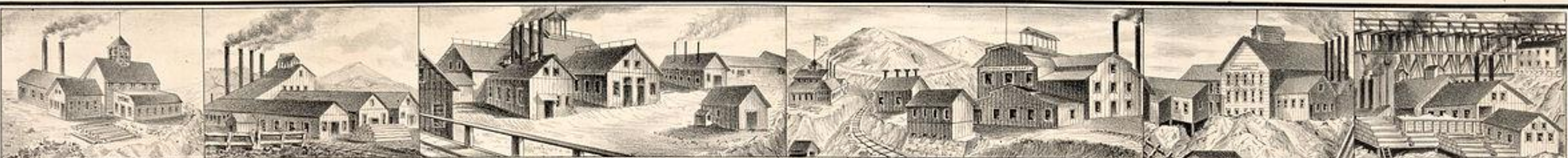

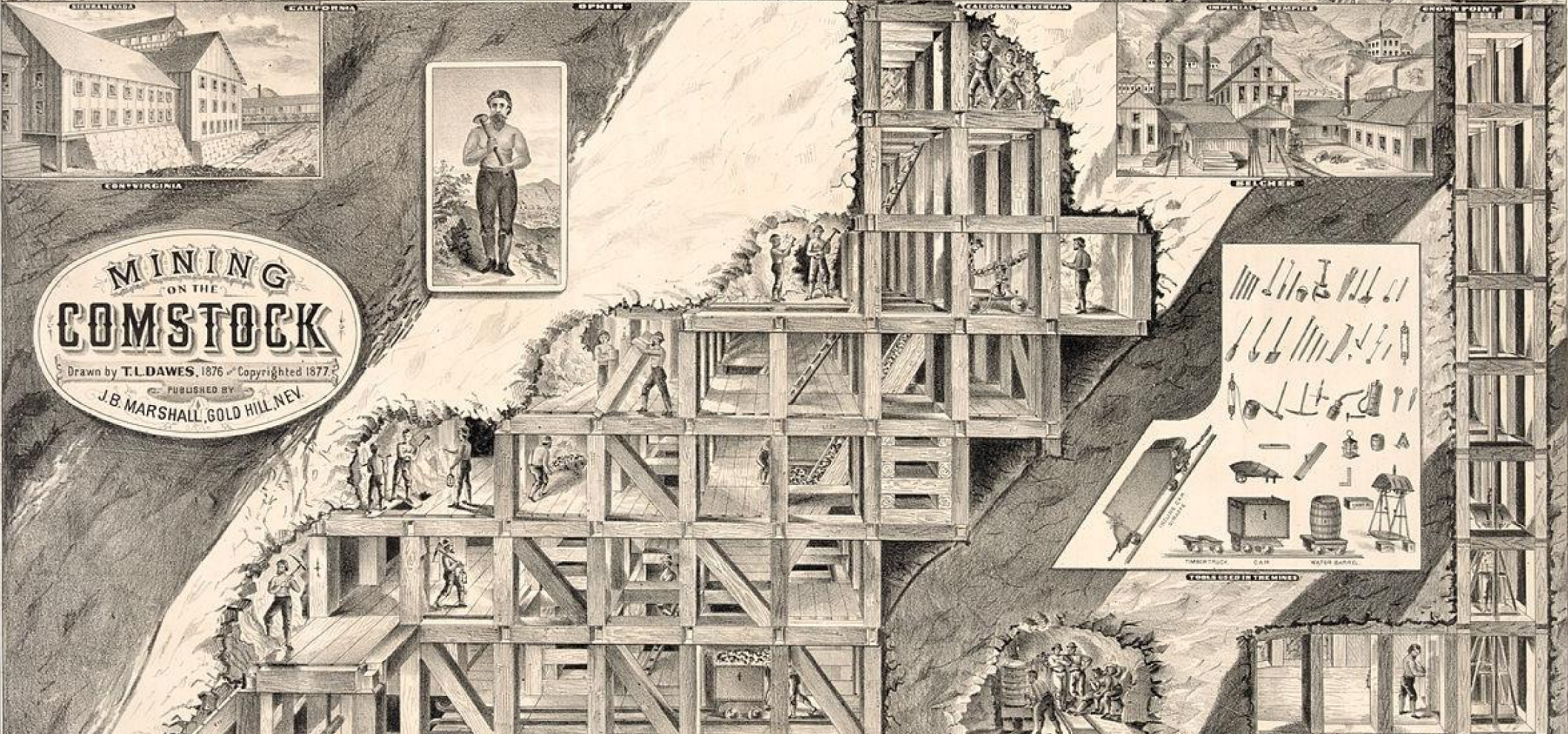

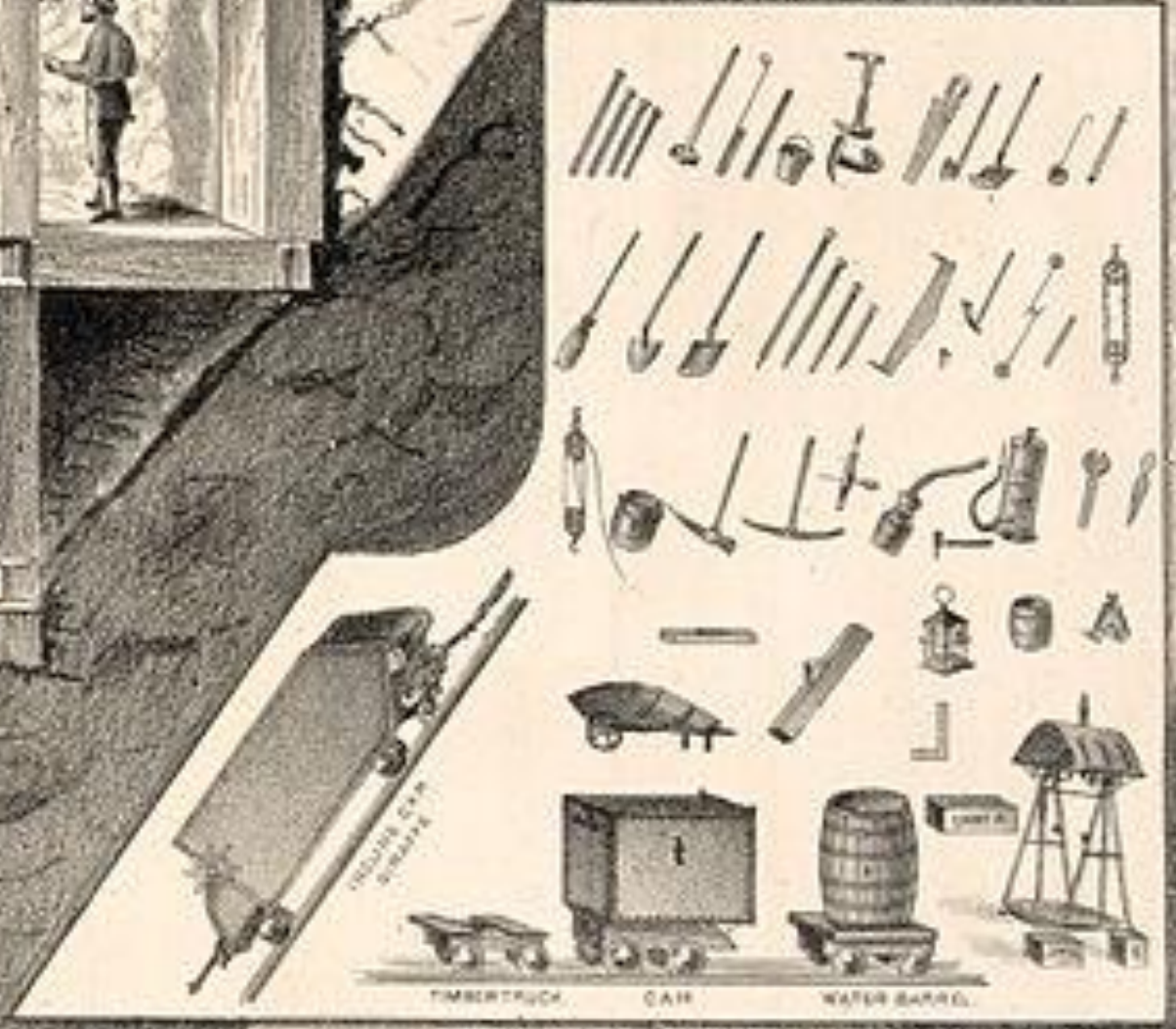

Keep company with me and you’ll learn to live freely and lightly.”

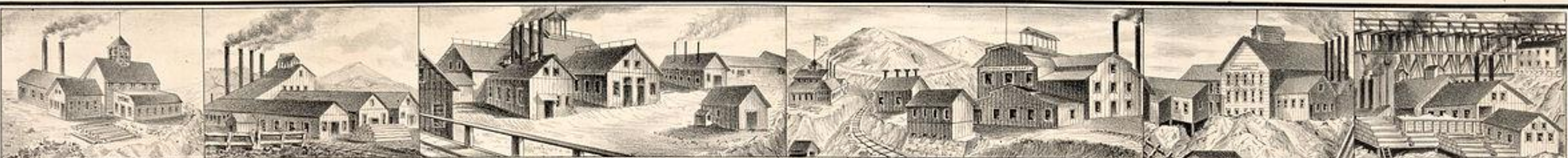

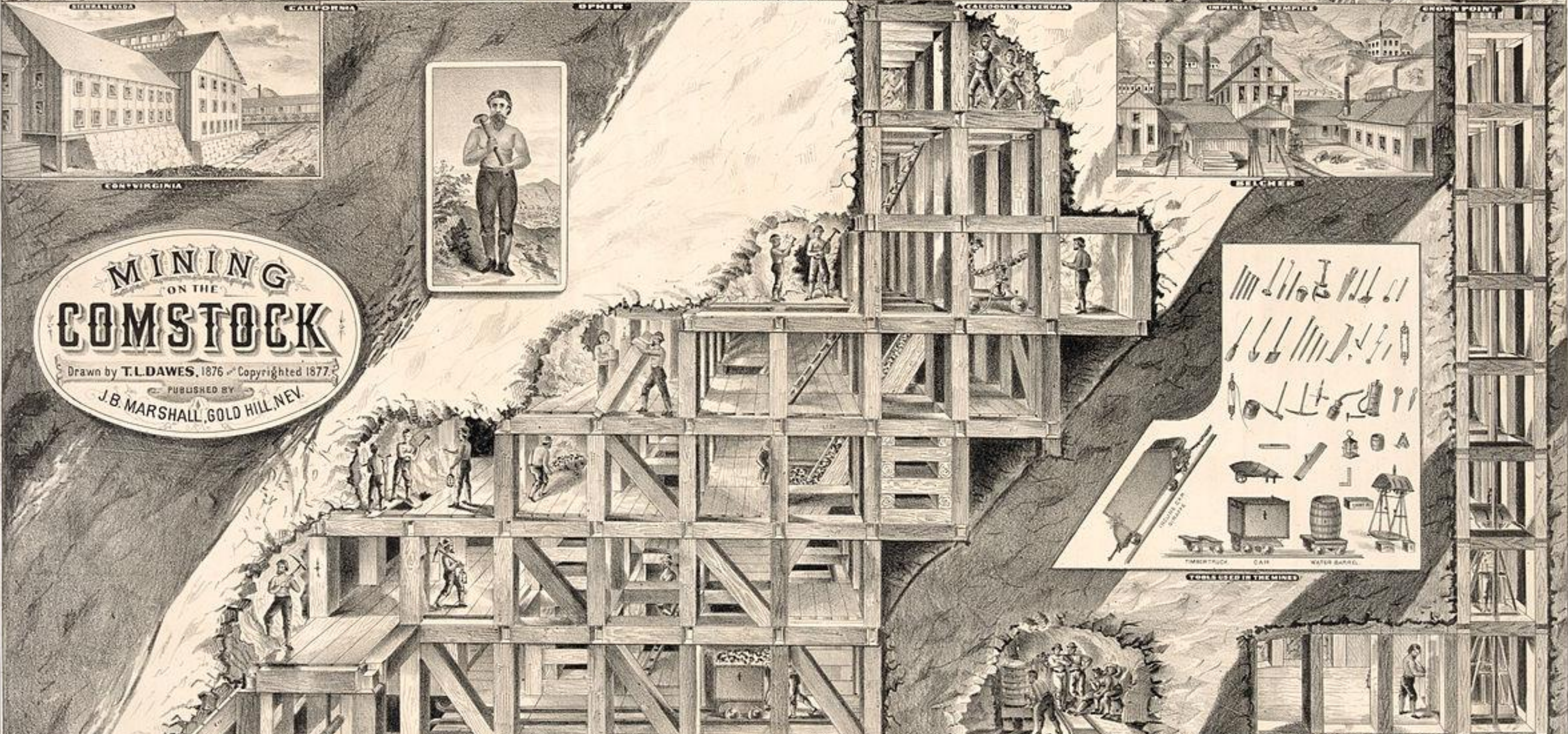
